MISSION STATEMENT

Open Space Advisory Group

MANDATE

To advise the Fremont Conservation Commission on the best ways to preserve and utilize open space in Fremont.

MISSION

To maintain the rural character of the Town while balancing the financial and environmental wishes of the townspeople, preserving the character of our community, protecting our water supply, and maintaining the existing wildlife habitat.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Provide information to the residents of Fremont on the benefits of preserving open space.
- Identify and prioritize open space in Fremont for possible preservation, and recommend purchase of desirable parcels according to the priority list as they become available.
- 3. Assist the Fremont Conservation Commission (FCC) in promoting the existing Town Forest assets.
- 4. Under the authority and direction of the FCC, assist in the maintenance of the existing Town Forest infrastructure and recommend opportunities for improvements and further development.
- 5. Act as an advisor for landowners who are considering maintaining their land as open space. Work with landowners who wish to transfer or sell the development rights for their land in order to preserve open space.
